



Attendance Policies

Exhibitors

Lumber producers with an annual production of 25 million board feet or more are requested to have a booth at the convention. The booth should be registered in the name of the producer. However, the producer can also attend in the name of a wholesaler or a sales company provided that this entity has a booth.

Equipment and service providers to the wood products industry can exhibit as well but with a limited number of booths available, priority will be given to lumber producers.

All attendees, including booth personnel, are required to submit individual registrations. The booth registration includes two booth personnel and must be paid in full in advance of the event.

The booths must be manned during the full extension of the trade show according to the hours specified in the convention program. Exhibitors are not allowed to dismantle their booth until the end of the trade show.

Not Eligible to Attend

Lumber producers with a production of 25 million board feet or more are not entitled to attend without a booth.

Badge Policy

Badges must be worn for admittance to all convention functions. Registrations based on bogus company affiliations and badge switching are embarrassing for all

concerned, are absolutely prohibited, and could lead to expulsion from the Montreal Wood Convention and forfeiture of registration fees.

No alterations to badges or business cards are allowed. Only registrants possessing valid credentials will be permitted entrance to the convention floor or any other convention function. To preserve the integrity of this event, registration requirements as determined by the Montreal Wood Convention will be strictly enforced.
